



Terms and Conditions

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A Certificate of Conformance signed by a company official shall accompany each shipment and contain the following information; Supplier Name, Purchase Order Number, Part Number, Revision, Quantity, Special Processes, Date, Authorized Signature, Title and Statement certifying product compliance and traceability.

Quality System

The Supplier shall maintain an effective Quality System in accordance with AS 9100, MIL-I-45208 or equivalent.

Right of Access

The Supplier agrees that any authorized representatives of organization, customer and regulatory authorities shall have access to and the right to examine any directly pertinent books, documents, papers and records of the Supplier involving transactions related to the purchase order to the extent necessary to verify the nature and extent of costs incurred under the purchase order.

Nonconforming Materials

The Supplier warrants all goods delivered under the purchase order to be free from defects in material and workmanship and to be of the quality, size and dimensions ordered and work performed under the purchase order to be in conformity with all plans, specifications and other data incorporated as part of the purchase order. The supplier agrees to repair, replace or otherwise correct any problem with the delivered item.

Notification of Changes

The Supplier shall notify PMF of any changes to the supplier product/process or change of plant location. Notification to PMF will be a requirement.

Control of Records

The Supplier shall maintain Control of Records for a period of 10 years and/or longer if required by the Purchase Order. Those records shall be maintained by the Supplier and be available if required.

DFARS Requirement

The Supplier certifies that all products supplied against the purchase order fully complies with DFARS Clause 252.225-7014, Preference of Domestic Specialty Metals including Alternate Clause 1.

ITAR Flow Down

If the order falls under the regulations of ITAR (International Traffic and Arms Regulations), all manufacturers, exporters, brokers of defense articles, defense services or related tech data are required to register with DDTC (Director of Defense Trade Controls). All license requirements imposed by ITAR are the sole responsibility of the subcontractor in possession of the purchase order.

Packaging Requirements

Packaging and packing shall be in accordance with best commercial practices. Methods used shall be sufficient for protection against damage from normal handling, shipping and storage conditions.
